

OFFICIAL TOWN OF SUDLERSVILLE NOTICE

The Sudlersville Town Commissioners hereby give notice that the previously scheduled election for May 18, 2026 has been cancelled.

At the Town Commissioner meeting held May 6, 2026, Town Commissioner Candidate Robert Stanton officially withdrew from the election.

The Sudlersville Charter Section 4-7 (b) states if, on the day immediately following the deadline for filing certificates for nomination for the office of Commissioner, the number of duly-qualified candidates for the office of Commissioner is equal to the number of vacancies in such office, then no election shall be held on the third Monday of May and all such candidates shall assume the office of Commissioner on the day immediately following the expiration of the fourth Monday of May.

As a result, Marcia Costa-Martin will serve her second three-year term. Frank Williams will begin his first three-year term. Both will be sworn in at the June 3, 2026 Town Commissioner meeting with terms expiring June 30, 2029.
