The minutes of the January 19, 2017 were approved as submitted with a motion by Elter and a second by Ruffner; a vote of 4-0 was entered.

The building permit log was reviewed. The building permit for the Elementary School was discussed.

Ford attended a QAC COG meeting where they discussed medical marijuana growth, production, and distribution in the County. The QAC Ordinance and the Church Hill Ordinance that discusses medical marijuana were reviewed and discussed. There were arguments for and against medical marijuana growth, production, and distribution within the town limits of Sudlersville. Topics discussed in detail were: allowing growth within town limits, what properties could be used for this use and how those properties are in relation to the schools, recreational marijuana being the next topic that will come along, drug addiction across the state and within the town, security requirements of this type of operation, how these operations can bring revenues to the town.
